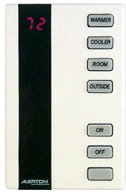


Alerton History: Key Milestones

 Founded in 1981 by three entrepreneurs, Alerton's name was created from their first names: Al, Clair and Tony who founded the company to provide building automation systems (BAS) for any size commercial building.

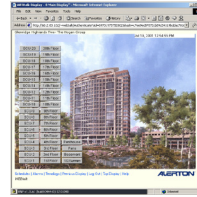
1985
 Alerton launches the Microset™, the industry's first intelligent zone sensor.



1996
 A pioneer in native BACnet®, Alerton introduces its first BACnet product: BACtalk!



2001
 Debut of WEBtalk™, providing browser access to a BAS.



2005
 BACtalk Control Modules (BCMs) launch offering a revolutionary modular approach to global control of a BAS.

Novar plc acquired by Honeywell.



2009
 Alerton introduces the VisualLogic Display (VLD), a networkable a custom-programmable BACnet thermostat.

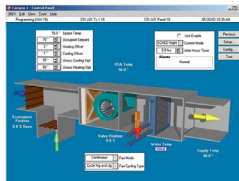


2011

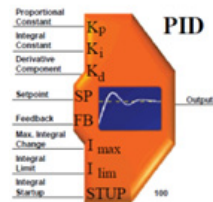
VLCA nominated for CSE magazine's Product of the Year.
